Waterfront - Boat Driver

JOB DESCRIPTION

Boat Drivers are part of the summer waterfront team, along with Lifeguards. This is a seasonal, summer position responsible for operating Camp's motorboats. They are responsible for safe operation of ski and pontoon boats and spend their time taking guests tubing, skiing, and wakeboarding, in addition to driving for late night cruises, fishing trips, Youth Camp shuttles, and staff events. Boat Drivers are also tasked with keeping each boat filled with gas and keeping the end of the dock and interior of the boats clean and organized. Boat Drivers report to the Waterfront Director.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Operate motor boats for the purposes of taking Camp guests skiing, wakeboarding, and tubing, along with pontoon cruises and other various pontoon trips
- Know and follow all NH State Marine Patrol guidelines and operate each boat accordingly
- Keep the dock clean and organized, including life jackets and helmets
- Help new skiers and wakeboarders succeed by offering tips and suggestions on the basics of the sport
- Keep boats clean and organized
- Fill boats with gas each morning and throughout the day if needed
- Maintain ski, tubing, wakeboard, and safety equipment and report any repairs needed to the Waterfront Director
- Assist the lifeguard team in keeping the beachfront clean
- Keep a friendly, patient demeanor when serving guests

REQUIREMENTS

- Must possess a NH Commercial Boating license (Camp can assist if needed)
- Good time management skills
- Thorough knowledge of NH State boating regulations
- Demonstrate skill in operating a speed boat safely and correctly
- A patient, accommodating spirit when working with guests on the water
