Childcare

JOB DESCRIPTION

Childcare programming is provided for our Family Camp guests. Childcare staff assist in maintaining a childcare program that provides a caring, warm environment in which parents may leave their children with confidence, while they enjoy chapel services and Camp activities. This is a seasonal, summer position where staff work with Pre-Campers (ages 3-7) and Nursery (under age 3). Childcare staff report to the Head of Childcare and Head of Nursery.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist in the care and safety of the children during chapel or family activities
- Make the parents feel comfortable in leaving their children
- Assist in the planning and execution of activities, games and Bible stories
- Assist in daily cleaning and organizing of the toys and rooms
- Assist in the thorough, deep cleaning of the rooms once a week
- Assist in cleaning the gym and chapel three times a week
- Assist in the weekly cleaning and turnover of Camp
- Assist in the operation of the beach snack shop by helping to cover the afternoon hours the shop is open
- Work one night per week in Knutes cafe

QUALIFICATIONS

- A sincere desire to serve the Lord with a “servant-like attitude”
- A genuine love and patience with little children
- Committed to following Jesus with a strong desire to see campers come to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ
- Able to follow instructions and submit to authority
- Ability to work on a team
