Photographer and Videographer

JOB DESCRIPTION

The Camp Photographer/Videographer is responsible for showing what God is doing at Camp by sharing the experience through pictures and videos. This is a role that requires a lot of time on your feet, bouncing around Camp to document daily activities and camp-wide events. The position works closely with senior leaders to share images with parents and create marketing content that embodies the culture and energy of Camp. This position reports to the Family and Youth Program Directors

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Capture photos and videos of all aspects of Camp life including chapel, sports, waterfront, dining, bunk life and activities for Youth Camp, Family Camp and Staff
- Collaborate with Camp staff to facilitate photo opportunities that capture meaningful Camp moments
- Take staged portraits of cabins, families, staff groups, etc.
- Edit and upload footage to Camp storage on a regular basis
- Collaborate to post photos to social media channels, website, and parent portal
- Produce slideshows and videos for end-of-week and end-of-summer
 - Videos/Slideshow for end of each week of Youth Camp
 - Video/Slideshow for end of Summer Staff
 - Provide pictures to Adult Activity Coordinator for Family Camp slideshow
- Manage Camp Flickr and Vimeo accounts and keep them up to date each week
- Exhibit good judgment and ability to gauge appropriate moments to document. Ensure behavior captured in footage reflects safety, inclusivity, and fun.

REQUIREMENTS

- Committed to the Christian faith and actively following Jesus with a life as outlined in the Bible
- Knowledge and skills necessary to take quality photos/videos
- The ability to work by yourself and collaborate with others when necessary
- Positive and approachable to help campers feel comfortable being photographed
