Conduct Agreement

Aftershock is designed to help campers grow in their faith, develop servant hearts, and experience what it means to live for Jesus in community. Our goal is that every camper would be challenged and encouraged to step deeper into their relationship with Christ, while building strong friendships and serving others.

This is only possible if each camper comes into this program with a humble, open, and teachable heart—ready to serve, respect others, and engage with what God may want to do in and through them. Participants of Aftershock are held to higher standards than any of our other camper programs. Participants must commit to conduct that is representative of camp's values, and must display a commitment to building the type of community we strive for. Listed below are explanations of those values and standards we will hold each Aftershocker to. Please read this through, and if you agree to be held by these standards this summer, sign it before arrival.

Show Respect to Counselors, Program Leaders, and Peers

I will show respect to the counselors, staff, and program leaders who have dedicated their time to guide me during Aftershock. This means listening carefully, following instructions, and maintaining a positive attitude, even when things are challenging. I will also treat my fellow campers with kindness and respect, creating a space where everyone feels valued, safe, and supported. I understand that no form of bullying or harassment is acceptable at Camp Spofford, and any case of physical or emotional abuse will result in disciplinary action, up to and including, dismissal from the program.

Come Ready to Serve

As a part of Aftershock, I understand that following Jesus means serving others with joy and humility. I will come ready to lend a hand, encourage my teammates, and do what is asked of me without grumbling. Whether it's helping with a project, including someone new, or showing kindness in small ways, I will put others before myself and reflect the heart of Christ in my actions.

Be Ready to Engage with Jesus

Aftershock is a time to slow down, listen, and grow spiritually. I will come with an open heart and mind, ready to meet with Jesus and learn from Him. I will participate fully in chapel times, devotionals, small group discussions, and quiet moments of reflection. I trust that God has something unique to show me during this program, and I want to be ready to receive it.
