Maintenance

JOB DESCRIPTION

Maintenance is a seasonal, summer position responsible for upkeep of campgrounds and general maintenance of camp equipment at the discretion of the Facilities Director. Upkeep of campgrounds typically takes the form of garbage collection and lawn care, while general maintenance would include but not be limited to trimming trees, gathering wood, and light carpentry. Additionally, the Facilities Director will call upon Maintenance for more major jobs, dependent on need.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Collect all garbage and put it in the dumpster
- Mow and trim the grounds on a weekly basis
- Do general maintenance which can include painting, light carpentry, trim trees, etc.
- Collect and set up wood for campfires as needed
- Assist the Facilities Director in any major jobs
- Make sure care and caution is used at all times in operating any piece of equipment
- Work in dish room one night per week and Knute's cafe one night per week

REQUIREMENTS

- Have a sincere desire to serve the Lord with a servant-like attitude
- Be able to follow instructions and submit to authority
- Be able to work together with others to form a team spirit
- Be able to handle strenuous work, often outside in hot weather
- Be available to accommodate the needs of guests
- Have a willingness to learn new skills
